Notice is given that an **Open Meeting** of the Board of Directors of the Comal Trinity Groundwater Conservation District will be held at the District office located at **9311 FM 311, Spring Branch, Texas 78070, on April 30, 2018, beginning at 6:00 pm.** This will be a Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors during which the Board will discuss and possibly take action to **adopt the following Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for the relevant aquifers managed by the District in Groundwater Management Area 10 (GMA 10):**


Relevant Aquifer in District	Desired Future Conditions Proposed for Adoption
Trinity Aquifer	Average regional well drawdown not exceeding 25 feet during average recharge conditions (including exempt and non-exempt use)

The possible action follows: proposal of these DFCs by resolution of GMA 10 on March 14, 2016; a public hearing on the proposed DFCs held by the District on May 15, 2016; adoption of the DFCs by resolution of GMA 10 on May 30, 2017; and notice of administrative completeness of the Explanatory Report prepared by GMA 10 for these DFCs by the Texas Water Development Board on February 12, 2018. Groundwater Conservation Districts located wholly or partially within Groundwater Management Area 10 are Edwards Aquifer Authority, Medina County Groundwater Conservation District, Uvalde County Underground Water Conservation District, Plum Creek Conservation District, Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District, Comal Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, and Kinney County Groundwater Conservation District.
