The Public Meeting of the Comal Trinity Groundwater Conservation District was duly noticed and held at 6:00 P.M. on April 30, 2018 at 9850 FM 311 Spring Branch, Texas 78070 (Curtis W. Bremer Emergency Services and Training Building)

1. Call to Order

President Larry Hull called to meeting to order at 6pm.

2. Declare a quorum

Quorum declared with Board members Larry Hull, Jensie Madden, Rob Johnson, and David Davenport in attendance. Larry Sunn, Jim Bower, and Clinton Dietert absent.

3. Pledge of Allegiance

Attendees recited the pledge.

4. Public comments

HL Saur covered the GMA 10 meeting held at 11:30am on April 30, 2018 regarding planning on the next DFC cycle. Mike Taylor, Crystal Clear SUD, asked that management of the aquifer be reasonable without the implementation of overly complicated requirements that create a burden to users.

5. Discuss and Consider Action related to final adoption of the proposed Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for the relevant aquifers in GMA 10 to be managed by the District

Board members have received and reviewed the documentation and resolution pertaining to the adoption of the DFC for relevant aquifers within the boundary of the District. The final DFC for the Trinity Aquifer in Comal County, excluding Uvalde and Bexar counties, reflects average regional well drawdown not exceeding 25 feet during average recharge conditions (including exempt and non-exempt use).


David Davenport made a motion to adopt the DFC and resolution; seconded by Rob Johnson; motion passes 4-0.

6. Correspondence


Larry Hull and HL Saur met with Senator Donna Campbell at her request to discuss general questions around groundwater.
